He loved the idea of building with materials from history, particularly clay. Yet, he wanted to make the product he was using even better. So, in 2002, after two years of experimentation, American Clay became a viable, mass-produced product. American Clay was awarded a final Patent (United States Patent 7485186) in February 2009. LOMATM

Loma[™] is our original earth plaster and our best-selling product. It conveys the essence of suede through its sensuous matte surfaces. Made with reclaimed marble sand and multiple clays, our patented formula offers a remarkable breadth of surface possibilities.

- Loma™ is the basecoat for our Porcelina™, Lomalina™ and Marittimo™ plasters. It is also used as a second coat over our Loma™ or Enjarre™ plasters .
- Approximately 180 square feet per 50 lb. bag (per coat).



Plaster: Porcelina™ + Color: Sugarloaf White

PORCELINA TO

Porcelina™ is satin-smooth and easily blended to achieve marble like surfaces. It is often compared to the Venetian plasters of Italy. The quality of our Porcelina™ is truly similar to the "porcelain" ceramic for which it was named.

- Porcelina™ is used as a second coat only.
- Approximately 300 square feet per 50 lb. bag (per coat).

Plaster: Lomalina™ + Color: Mystic

LOMALINATM

Lomalina™ integrates the best of two worlds...smooth porcelain-like finish combined with the luminous and subtle texture of Loma™. With the application ease of Loma™ and the silky softness of Porcelina™, Lomalina™ is a truly desirable finish.

- Lomalina™ is used as a second coat only.
- Approximately 200 square feet per 50 lb. bag (per coat).

MARITTIMO

Marittimo™ is a name created with the "sea" (or "mar") at its core. Marittimo™ uses recycled, crushed shells from the U.S. Gulf Coast. This unique finish has a smooth waxy feel or a sandy textured finish depending on your choice of application.

- Marittimo™ is used as a second coat only.
- Approximately 160 square feet per 50 lb. bag (per coat).



Enjarre[™]

Enjarre™ is our only single-coat product. This application eliminates some of the labor and cost typically involved in finishing a wall. It can be applied to achieve a range of finishes, from smooth to rustic or textured.

- Enjarre™ can also be used as a base coat for our other finishes.
- Approximately 100 square feet per 63 lb. bag (per coat).

Plaster: Porcelina™

Color: Sugarloaf White (Lime Washed)



- Our color packs contain natural pigments which are pre-measured to be added to one bag of plaster. Each color pack will vary in weight depending on how much pigment is used to create that specific color.
- Up & EZ! is a binder that is mixed with the plaster to increase the workability and strengthen the final surface.
- Primer Sand is mixed with an approved paint primer* and then rolled onto your wall to create tooth that aids our plaster adhering to the surface.
- We also offer mica and straw textural additives, sealers and lime putty to create almost any finish you can possibly imagine.

ABOUT OUR COLORS

With 224 total color options our standard colors are just the beginning of American Clay's extensive offerings. We also offer blended colors which make it easy to create a perfect palette for your project.

Although our colors are represented on our website as well as in our printed booklet, it is always best to obtain an actual sample before making your final selection. Our color pigment packs come in a dry powder form and are easily mixed with our clay plaster. As our colors are derived from all natural materials, they are resistant to the UV fading often associated with petroleum colorants.

COLOR POLICY

We are using natural pigments and materials that can vary in strength and hue from batch to batch. Although color variations are closely monitored it is a good idea to buy all pigment and plaster for a project from the same lot. If that is not possible, be sure to batch your plaster and pigment materials together to decrease these variations.

With this in mind, we encourage your applicator to make sample boards or on-site sample walls in order for you to approve final finish and color.


